## Stay and Play


As you know, the before and after school care, 'Stay and Play' has been under review as we continue to ensure it is safe, self-funding and therefore viable. Thank you for your support as we implement changes which we hope will ensure that the facility can continue to be offered and that make the best use of staff within school. Historically Mrs Maynard has run Stay and Play, but as her responsibilities for other areas of school increase we have to simplify things.

Therefore, from after the Easter holidays we are introducing a flat rate for both the morning and afternoon sessions as follow:

Morning Session	First child	Additional children from the same family
8.00am - 8.45am	£2	£1

Afternoon session	First child	Additional children from the same family
3.15pm - 4.00pm	£2	£1
3.15pm- 4.30pm	£3	£1.50

There will be a facility whereby you can pay on ParentMail if you so wish, but we will continue to take cash/cheques if you prefer. As before we would ask that children are booked in advance, not on the day to ensure we don't have too many children. We have recently appointed Mr Crittall as a sports apprentice. Mr Crittall will be working throughout the school during curriculum time supporting PE and developing activities at breaks and lunchtimes. In addition he will be working alongside Mrs Lawson



at all morning Stay and Play sessions except Wednesday. Mr Crittall will be leading groups for all sorts of fun physical activities during this time. What a lovely way to start the day! There will of course also be the usual activities.

Mr Crittall will also be supporting the after school sessions, alongside Mrs Hobson, in the first half term. In time he will begin to take sports clubs, but the stay and play children will benefit from his skill and expertise in the first instance.

I thank you for your understanding and I look forward to seeing the children enjoying the opportunity of additional specialist support.
