| <p>Monday 22nd June</p> <p>WALT: Write descriptive paragraphs.</p> | <p>Have you heard of the story of Snow White and the Seven Dwarves? Can you name any of the characters or the setting? What happens at the end? If you don't know the story, read through the PowerPoint.</p> | <p>Choose a character from the character description sheets and circle the adjectives you think best describes them. Write some paragraphs to describe your character using these words, as well as some adjectives and adverbs of your own! You need to describe their appearance (what they look like) as well as their personality (what sort of person they are). Repeat using another character description sheet. <i>You will need: Snow White PowerPoint and character description sheets.</i></p> |
| <p>Tuesday 23rd June</p> <p>WALT: Write a diary entry.</p> | <p>Think about what makes each of the dwarves the person they are. In yesterday's PowerPoint, the dwarves are called Dozy, Grouchy, Merry, Prof, Silly, Sniffy and Blushful. In the Disney film, they are called Sleepy, Grumpy, Happy, Doc, Dopey, Sneezy and Bashful. Why do you think they have these names? Look up any meanings if you are unsure.</p> | <p>Write a diary entry from the point of view of one of the dwarves. What did you do today? Who was with you? How were you feeling? Remember to write in the past tense as you are writing about things that have already happened. <i>You will need: Diary writing checklist.</i></p> |
| <p>Wednesday 24th June</p> <p>WALT: Write persuasively.</p> | <div data-bbox="465 1078 748 1436" data-label="Image"></div> <p>Think about the Evil Queen's magic mirror.</p> <p>Where did she get it from? Does anyone else know she has it? What other questions does she ask the mirror? Who speaks back from inside the mirror?</p> | <p>Design a persuasive poster advertising a magic mirror for sale. Use last week's word mat pack to find unusual and interesting words to use.</p> <p><i>Remember to include:</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ short, snappy phrases, ✓ an eye catching layout, ✓ a catchy slogan, ✓ attention grabbing pictures, ✓ a final reminder of the product. <p>Also you could add: who owns it? Why is it for sale?</p> |

| <p>Thursday 25th June</p> <p>WALT: Write an informal letter.</p> | <p>Imagine you are Snow White.</p> <p>You are at the point in the story where you are living happily with the dwarves in their cottage. How are you feeling after everything that has just happened? What are your hopes for the future? What have you left behind at the palace?</p> | <p>Pretend you are Snow White.</p> <p>Write a letter to your best friend telling them what has recently happened to you. Not only have you lost your father, but your wicked stepmother has tried to get rid of you! You have now found a safe place to stay with the dwarves.</p> <p>Include some of the answers to the questions you have just been thinking about. You could be writing the letter just as an old lady with some apples knocks on the door...</p> <p>Make up an address to put at the top, then start your letter with 'Dear'. <i>From last week: Writing a letter display poster.</i></p> |
| <p>Friday 26th June</p> <p>WALT: Present my findings.</p> | <p><i>Fact:</i> The story of Snow White was first published by the Brothers Grimm in 1812. Walt Disney had the idea of retelling the fairy tale at the age of 15 after watching a silent movie version. 'Snow White and the Seven Dwarves' was released in 1937 and was Walt Disney's first full length animated film.</p> <p><i>Did you know?</i> Walt Disney was given a special award for this film at the Oscars in 1939. As well as the usual Oscar statue, he was awarded with seven smaller Oscars too!</p> | <p>How many films have the Disney Company made that are based upon fairy tales? Which ones have you seen? Do you have a favourite?</p> <p>Pick one of the films and make a fact file about it. This could be on paper or using a computer.</p> <p>Which fairy tale is it based upon and who wrote the original story? Does the film have any well-known songs? How are the fairy tale and film similar and different?</p> <p><i>Ideas:</i> Tangled, The Princess and the Frog, Sleeping Beauty, Frozen, The Little Mermaid or Beauty and the Beast.</p> |
