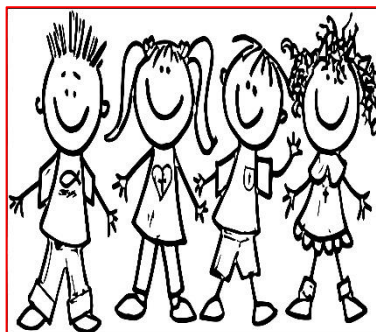

- Focused intervention and pastoral support TA & ELSA

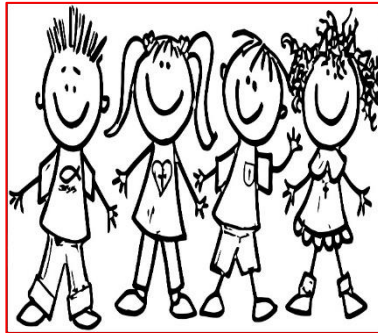
Small group support

- Small group teaching enables teachers to focus exclusively on a small number of learners. TAs with other groups though groups are regularly swapped around.

ELSA training and delivery

- Dedicated ELSA TA
- Support offered on a 1:1 basis or in small group
- Working in conjunction with PFSA support offered to families
- Attendance support included.

Supplemented swimming /school camp
